

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PLEASE READ AND SIGN BELOW

The Fair is strictly for the jewellery trade. Admission will ONLY be granted to:

Jewellers • Agents/Distributors • Jewellery Retailers • Department/Duty Free Stores • Jewellery Manufacturers • Watch and Clock Retailers • Watch and Clock Manufacturers/Repairers • Gemmologists • Student (of a Jewellery-related course) • Watch and Clock Manufacturers/Repairers

- Visitors who register on site at the Fair will be required to provide the same documentation as on reverse.
- Visitor entry passes must be visible at all times whilst at the Fair and photographic identification issued under law (eg. current Australian Driver's Licence or Passport) must be carried. Visitors who are not Australian residents must carry their passport with them at the Fair at all times.
- Please note: At entry, visitors must wear their Fair badge and have photographic identification ready to show Security. Visitors must produce identification on demand to Security or to any exhibitor with whom they may have dealings.
- It is a condition of entry to the Fair that all visitors and exhibit personnel consent to being searched at any time. X-Ray machines and metal detection equipment will be used at entry points. Security stations will be located at the entry and exit points, at which routine searches will be conducted of persons entering and leaving the Fair.
- All visitors and exhibitor personnel will be filmed during the Fair. Visitors may not wear helmets, hats or sunglasses inside the Fair, which prevent visual identification.
- Visitors may not bring the following into the Fair: Firearms or weapons of any kind, Cameras and Bags other than small briefcases or handbags.
- Visitors are not permitted to bring goods to the Fair to trade, sell, display or represent on the floor. Those found doing so will be removed from the Fair immediately and may be prohibited from attending future Jewellery Fairs.
- Expertise Events reserves the right to refuse entry to any visitor at its discretion.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

In registering for the JAA International Jewellery Fair, visitors agree that they shall observe and comply with these rules and regulations and with the rules and regulations of the Sydney Exhibition Centre.

Conduct in the Sydney Exhibition Centre

- Visitors shall not do, or permit anything to be done, which shall cause a disturbance, nuisance, annoyance, inconvenience, damage to any person or thing or which in the opinion of the Organiser does not conform with the general standards of the Exhibition or amounts to a breach of these rules and regulations or applicable laws and regulations generally applying.
- Visitors may not bring any camera, video recording equipment of any kind to the Exhibition without the prior written consent of the Organiser. The Organiser reserves the right to search the belongings of any visitor at any time.
- It is expressly prohibited for visitors to record images in any form while attending the Exhibition without the prior written consent of the Organiser. Such prohibition includes, but is not limited to, the taking of photographs, video recording of any type and drawing or sketching of images. Visitors agree to surrender to the Organiser on demand any material on which images may be recorded in violation of this rule, including but not limited to film, video tapes, sketchbooks, camera phones and digital storage devices.
- Should a visitor in breach of the above rule record any image, the copyright and other intellectual property or other rights (including the avoidance of doubt, rights in sound recording and broadcasts) whether arising now or in the future shall vest in the Organiser unconditionally and immediately on the creation or recording of the images. The visitor undertakes to execute all deeds and documents and to do all things as the Organiser may require to vest in the Organiser including, without limitation, delivery of the images or copies of them in any media.
- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse admittance to any visitor or to require any visitor to leave if in their opinion his or her behaviour is in breach of these rules and regulations or of any rules and regulations of the Sydney Exhibition Centre. The opinion of the Organiser is final in this regard.

Liability

- The Organiser shall not be liable to any visitor for any loss of or damage to any of his or her property occurring (from whatever cause) in or about the Sydney Exhibition Centre nor for the death of or any injury sustained by any visitor whilst on or leaving the Sydney Exhibition Centre (other than for death or injury resulting from negligence to the extent this cannot be excluded or restricted at law and then only to such extent).
- The visitor agrees that the Organiser shall not incur any liability to him or her for any products displayed or sold by any exhibitor at the Exhibition.
- Each visitor agrees to indemnify and hold the Organiser harmless, on demand, against all claims, liabilities, losses, suits, proceedings, damages, judgments, expenses, costs (including legal fees) and charges of any kind howsoever incurred by or on behalf of or made against the Organiser arising out of any infringement or other claim relating to or arising out of the unauthorised taking of any images by that visitor.
- The visitor agrees that the Organiser shall not incur any liability to him or her for any error or omission in any information relating to any exhibitor or its products in the Exhibition's official directory or in any other promotional or other printed materials or information provided by the Organiser or that exhibitor.
- No waiver by the Organiser of any of the provisions of these rules and regulations or of any of its rights hereunder shall have effect unless given in writing and signed by any [Director] of the Organiser.

Personal Data

- Visitors agree that the personal data provided for registration for the Exhibition may be included in the JAA International Jewellery Fair's database and used by the Organiser.
- For security purposes and in order to prevent and detect crime, visitors may undergo a random bag search and CCTV camera recording on the Fair floor. This information will not be disclosed to third parties without your prior approval, unless requested by police.

Governing Law & Jurisdiction

- These rules and regulations shall be governed by and construed in all respects in accordance with the laws of Australia and all visitors submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Australian courts.
